There was only one problem - I was in so much pain while riding, due to a broken and protruding tail bone, that I would be in tears during and after the rides. I tried many gel pads and even resorted to riding with a rubber tube tied on to my saddle. How embarrassing but that's how much pain I was in and how much I wanted to be riding.

I started out in a synthetic saddle, moving to a Tucker, and on to a Circle Y. The saddles continued to keep my tailbone bruised and aching all the time thus my need for pain medications increased. I really thought I would have to give up my new found passion of riding when a friend of ours listened to my woes and suggested I try his Easyride Saddle. I looked at his saddle but thought the high back seat would only aggravate my problem. It took a few months for him to convince me to try his saddle. He offered to let me ride in it for a full day's ride which is when you KNOW the difference. I was skeptical but desperate. Something was different the first five minutes of the ride. There was nothing touching my tailbone because the seat was high enough to go around it instead of on it. I felt secure and pain free. Not only did it resolve my tailbone problem but the seat was padded and felt great in the areas that can wear quickly on a woman. I was sold by the end of the ride. I ordered one immediately and have never looked back recommending them to everyone I know.
